Detailed Project Description

The overall objective of RWSS projects is to improve and sustain access to water and sanitation services in rural communities through a decentralized, district-based implementation and management model. In Igunga and Kondoa Districts, EEPCO implemented demand-responsive and sustainable Community Water Supply Services in 20 villages.

Project activities included:

- Provision of basic drinking water and sanitation facilities
- Strengthening of community capacity for planning, implementing, operating and maintaining their facilities. Formation and training of Water User Associations (WUA) and WatSan committees
- Integration of water supply and sanitation with hygiene education to maximize the project's health benefits
- District-level capacity building for District Councils, the private sector and NGOs
- Promotion and provision of rural water supply and sanitation facilities which are appropriate, affordable, and acceptable to their users
